A. Measure A Revenue Received to Date & Reserve Update

The cumulative Measure A revenues received in the current fiscal year total approximately \$74.7M. The 25% portion of the revenues for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 and allocated by the Board of Supervisors is projected to be approximately \$46.1M.

Member McCorriston asked what might explain the significant increase in monthly revenue reported in December of FY 19-20. HCSA Staff will check to see if there is any data available to explain the amount reported.
