The Committee asked HCSA staff to draft a letter to Supervisor Haggerty from Louis (Chair, Oversight Committee) expressing concern that GLOM has not responded to the requests for a completed reporting form, indicating that the lack of compliance will be noted in the final report (should GLOM fail to comply) and recommending an audit of Measure A funds allocated. The letter will be sent to Supervisor Haggerty with a copy sent to GLOM.
