### II. Announcements & Updates

- A. Oversight Committee Membership Update
  - 1. Central Labor Council (Seat No. 2)
    - Terry Sandoval's appointment was approved at the 4/23 Board of Supervisors Meeting. She took the oath last week and is now an official member of this Committee.
  - 2. City of Berkeley (Seat No. 10)
    - Al Murray's appointment was approved at the 5/21 Board of Supervisors Meeting. He took the oath earlier this week and is now an official member of this Committee.
  - 3. Public Health Commission (Seat No. 5)
    - The Public Health Commission submitted a letter of resignation for Nancy Shemick effective June 30<sup>th</sup>). The paperwork is scheduled for approval at a June Board Meeting. The Commission also submitted a nomination letter for Gwendolyn McCain who will attend meetings as a member of the public until her nomination is approved by the Board of Supervisors.

#### B. Additional

- Rebecca Gebhart and James Nguyen provided the Measure A Orientation to the Board of Supervisors and their staff on April 30<sup>th</sup>. Rebecca recommended HCSA staff provide an annual Measure A orientation as staff may change.
- James reported that new Measure A Oversight Committee Members also receive a Measure A Orientation.

#### III. Review of Minutes

- A. Meeting Minutes from April 26, 2013
  - John Becker moved to approve the minutes for April 26, 2013. Al Murray seconded the motion. Art Chen and Kay Eisenhower abstained. The motion passed.

### IV. Update: Finance/Budget

- A. Alameda County Healthcare Tax (Sales, Use and Transactions Tax Receipts) Report
  - Rebecca confirmed that online sales tax revenue is included with Measure A revenue. She
    will follow up with sales tax consultants for this specific information and provide an update
    at a future meeting.

- B. Measure A Revenue Received to Date
  - Total revenue for FY 12/13 to date is ~\$22.5 million for Alameda County (not including allocation for Alameda Health System (dba Alameda County Medical Center), which is slightly above the revenue received for the same period one year ago. Based on the current trend, the projected final total (not including the allocation for Alameda Health System) is approximately ~\$30.4 million.
- C. County Funding to Alameda Health System (dba Alameda County Medical Center)
  - Rebecca noted the amount provided from Administration/Indigent Health is projected to reduce as a result of reduction in federal funding.
- D. Review of FY 12/13 Measure A Board Letters for Measure A One-Time Allocations (handouts)
  - 1. July 24, 2012 (\$150,000 for Eden Youth and Family Center and increase in Measure A Allocation to day laborers from \$150,000 to \$225,000)
  - 2. Sept. 11, 2012 (\$100,000 for Preventive Care Pathways to provide indigent health care services)
- E. Measure A Reauthorization
  - James shared there are no new updates.
- F. FY 12/13 Measure A contracts approved by the Board
  - The Committee recommended discussing at a future meeting a public process to allocate unallocated Measure A funds and provide feedback on how the County determines current community need.
