II. Oath of Office

III. Review of Minutes

• Jay Garfinkle, MD motioned to adopt the meeting minutes from December 21, 2007; motion seconded by Don Sheppard; motion passed.

IV. Review of Materials

- Jennifer Chan reviewed the materials provided, which included:

 - 3. Board letter: Approval of Contracts Utilizing Supervisory District 2 and Supervisory District 4 FY 07/08 Measure A "Other" Funds;
 - 4. Statement of Economic Interest Form 700 for 2007/2008 (which must be completed and submitted to Jennifer no later than April 1, 2008);

V. Announcements

- Jennifer Chan announced that Adele Amodeo has resigned from the Oversight Committee; Adele was appointed by Supervisor Keith Carson; his office has been notified and will be responsible with finding a replacement;
- Jennifer also announced that Dr. Lisa Warhuus has been nominated by City of Berkeley Mayor Tom Bates to replace the vacancy created by Peter Manoleas' resignation; Dr. Warhuus will begin her appointment on the Oversight Committee following completion of the next report;

- Jennifer also informed the Committee that Supervisor Lai-Bitker has not yet found a replacement for Ron Silva:
- Ron Tauber announced that he resigned from the Mental Health Board to accept a position as President
 of the Alameda County Mental Health Association; Ron plans to remain on the Measure A Oversight
 Committee until a replacement is recommended by the Mental Health Board.

VI. Report Planning and Preparation

- The Committee reviewed the draft report and suggested changes and/or edits including:
 - Inclusion of the begin and end date of the County fiscal year on the cover;
 - Specify funding allocation changes in fiscal years 05/06 and 06/07 in the executive summary;
 - Kay Eisenhower will update the State of Health Care section for the next report (also change the heading from State of Health Care to State of Health Care Funding)
 - Include a map of agencies who received capital awards;
 - Include an explanation of how schools were chosen under the School-Based / Linked Health Center allocation; also include data on the number of uninsured treated through this program;
 - Include data on the number of visits provided by the Bay Area Consortium for Quality Health Care; reformat concerns into paragraph form;
 - Include section on \$125,000 allocation the Healthy Oakland (HCSA will write);
 - Include map of primary care CBOs;
- Larry Platt, MD moved that a recommendation be included in the sections regarding capital funding allocations that the Board of Supervisors include a provision in future capital allocation that recipients provide a specified level of health services to indigent, low income and/or uninsured patients; motion seconded by Louis Chicoine; Louis moved to amend the motion to include the level of health services provided to indigent, low income and/or uninsured patients be determined by Health Care Services Agency staff; amendment accepted by Larry; motion passed;
- Ron Tauber recommended that a member of the Oversight Committee be given the opportunity to participate in future capital RFP planning and processes; Kay Eisenhower recommended that a subcommittee be formed to focus on future capital funding allocations;
- Oversight Committee members were asked to review the draft report in greater detail paying particular attention to the red notes; Committee members who were responsible for writing specific sections were asked to submit revisions to Jennifer by February 8th; a revised draft will be sent to Committee members prior to the next meeting;
- Brad Cleveland moved to hire a consultant to assist in the development of the full report and the development of a brochure that will include highlights from the report; motion seconded by Louis Chicoine; Neil Marks moved to amend the motion to include a press release; amendment accepted; Beth Pollard motioned to table the discussion until the next meeting; seconded by Kay Eisenhower, motion passed (with 2 opposed); HCSA staff will bring information to the next meeting on the amount of available funds for a consultant and any other relevant information.
