II. Review of Minutes

- 1. Adele Amodeo motioned to adopt the meeting minutes from March 23, 2007
- 2. Motion seconded by Don Sheppard
- 3. Motion passed

III. Announcements

- Dave Kears announced that a draft Board letter regarding the reallocation of Measure
 A funds was sent to the Board health staff for review; the Board letter will be
 presented to the full Board for review and comment at a May retreat; the letter will be
 shared with the Oversight Committee once Board members have had a chance to
 review
- Jennifer Chan informed the Committee that the letter regarding their recommendations (of a one-year allocation and the implementation of a cost of living adjustment) has been drafted and will be mailed to each Supervisor next week
- Jennifer explained there was an oversight on the agenda and that the issue of supplantation had not be agendized as requested at the last meeting; Art Geen moved to agendize the issue of supplantation for the next meeting, motion seconded by Neil Marks, motion passed
- Jennifer informed Committee members of Charlie Ridgell's resignation from the Committee; the Central Labor Council has appointed Phil Hayes who will, hopefully, be joining the Committee at the next meeting

- Jennifer shared information that the Oversight Committee's written report of FY 04/05 expenditures has received 85 hits since being posted on the Health Care website in February
- Jennifer explained the handouts provided:
 - 1. Copies of Board letters to date
 - 2. Sample Agreements / Contracts/ Documents these documents were provided to give Committee members a sense of some of Health Care Service Agency's contract requirements; a sample indigent contract was also passed around to Committee members
 - 3. List of members on 2-year term limits
 - 4. Draft reporting document forms
- Regarding the issue of contract monitoring and compliance, the Committee reiterated its interest in hearing from program staff to improve understanding program oversight mechanisms

IV. 2-year Term Limit Members

• Jennifer explained that the term of members listed on the handout would end November 1, 2007; she asked that members who are interested in continuing their participation let her know so that she could inform the nominating agency; Jennifer will contact the listed members in the next couple of weeks to check in; members who are reappointed will serve a 4-year term

V. Discussion / Planning Joint Meeting

- Art Geen motioned to have the Health Care Services staff arrange 2 meetings with the Oversight Committee, one with the Alameda County Board of Supervisors and one with the Alameda County Medical Center Board of Trustees; motion seconded by Kay Eisenhower, motion passed (7-yes, 4-no, 1-abstain)
- The Committee hopes to have a dialogue with the Alameda County Board of Supervisors regarding the group's overall goals and guiding principles, and best practices in determining a reasonable reserve; the Committee prefers to have this meeting scheduled on a regular meeting date and would like to proceed so long as all 5 Supervisors are invited and at least 2 can attend; Jennifer will keep the Committee updated on scheduling; the Committee would like time to prepare the agenda for the meeting (before it occurs)
- With respect to the Alameda County Medical Center Board of Trustees (BOT), the Committee would like the BOT to meet separate from the Alameda County Medical Center staff / administration

VI. Planning and Preparation for Review of FY 05/06 and 06/07 Expenditures

- a. Review and Revision of Reporting Documents
 - The Committee reviewed the draft reporting documents and made suggested changes
 - The budget worksheet requesting information from funding recipients was eliminated
 - Rich Ambrose motioned to have Health Care Services staff create the format and provide the information for the Committee's review of financial information (including aggregate budget information and Measure A allocations); motion seconded by Sal Tedesco; motion passed

- The Committee agreed it would be important to include performance indicators when looking at the various programs and how their Measure A funds were spent
- b. Finalize Decisions on Written Reports and/or Presentations from Fund Recipients
 - Written reports will be requested from all funding recipients
 - The Committee will hear presentations on
 - Medicare Part D
 - Capital Request for Proposal
 - Other Capital
 - Administration / Infrastructure Support
 - Allocation of reduction targets under Administration / Indigent Health,
 Public Health and Behavioral Health Care
 - Board of Supervisors Allocations
 - Criminal Justice Screening / In-Custody Services
 - Glen Dyer Jail
 - Juvenile Hall
 - Bay Area Consortium for Quality Health Care
 - Alameda County Medical Center
 - The Committee may request additional information or request additional presentations upon receipt and review of written reports
- c. Development of Reporting Timeline
 - Written report requirements for FY 05/06 will be sent to all funding recipients in the next 2 weeks, with a deadline for completion and submission on June 15th
 - Written report requirements for FY 06/07 will be distributed following the close of the fiscal year, with a deadline for completion and submission one month following
 - The Committee will hear reports on Medicare Part D, Capital Request for Proposal, Other Capital and Administration / Infrastructure Support at the next meeting; reports to be presented by Health Care Services staff
 - The Committee would like to put its report of FY 05/06 and 06/07 out in December 2007
