

**ALAMEDA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION  
RESOLUTION NO. 2006-04**

**APPROVING THE UPDATE OF THE SPHERE OF INFLUENCE FOR THE  
CURBSIDE RECYCLING COUNTY SERVICE AREA**

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 56425 et seq. requires the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) to develop and determine the sphere of influence (SOI) of each local governmental agency within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 56425(f) requires that LAFCo review and update the adopted SOI boundaries, as necessary, not less than once every five years; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 56430 requires that a municipal services review be conducted prior to or in conjunction with a SOI update; and

**WHEREAS**, LAFCo conducted a municipal services review of the services provided by the Curbside Recycling County Service Area (CSA) and adopted written determinations as required by Government Code Section 56430 on November 10, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, the CSA's SOI is currently coterminous with its service boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, no change in regulation, land use or development will occur as a result of updating the CSA's SOI; and

**WHEREAS**, in the form and manner prescribed by law, the Executive Officer has given notice of a public hearing by this Commission regarding the location of this SOI map;

**WHEREAS**, the SOI update was duly considered at a public hearing held on January 12, 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alameda LAFCo heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence that were made, presented or filed, and all persons present were given an opportunity to appear and be heard with respect to any matter pertaining to said action.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Alameda LAFCo hereby:

1. Retain the existing the SOI for the Curbside Recycling CSA as generally depicted in Exhibit A attached hereto.
2. Adopt the following SOI Policy:
  - Policy Recommendation #1: LAFCo to work with County to clarify CSA service boundaries.
3. Consider the criteria set forth in Government Code Section 56425(e) and determine as follows:
  - (a) *The present and planned land uses in the area, including agricultural and open-space lands* – Existing land within the CSA includes small pockets of residential communities, which will continue to grow. Important open space and agricultural land is not found in the SOI. Therefore, areas included with this SOI update do not affect agricultural lands. County land

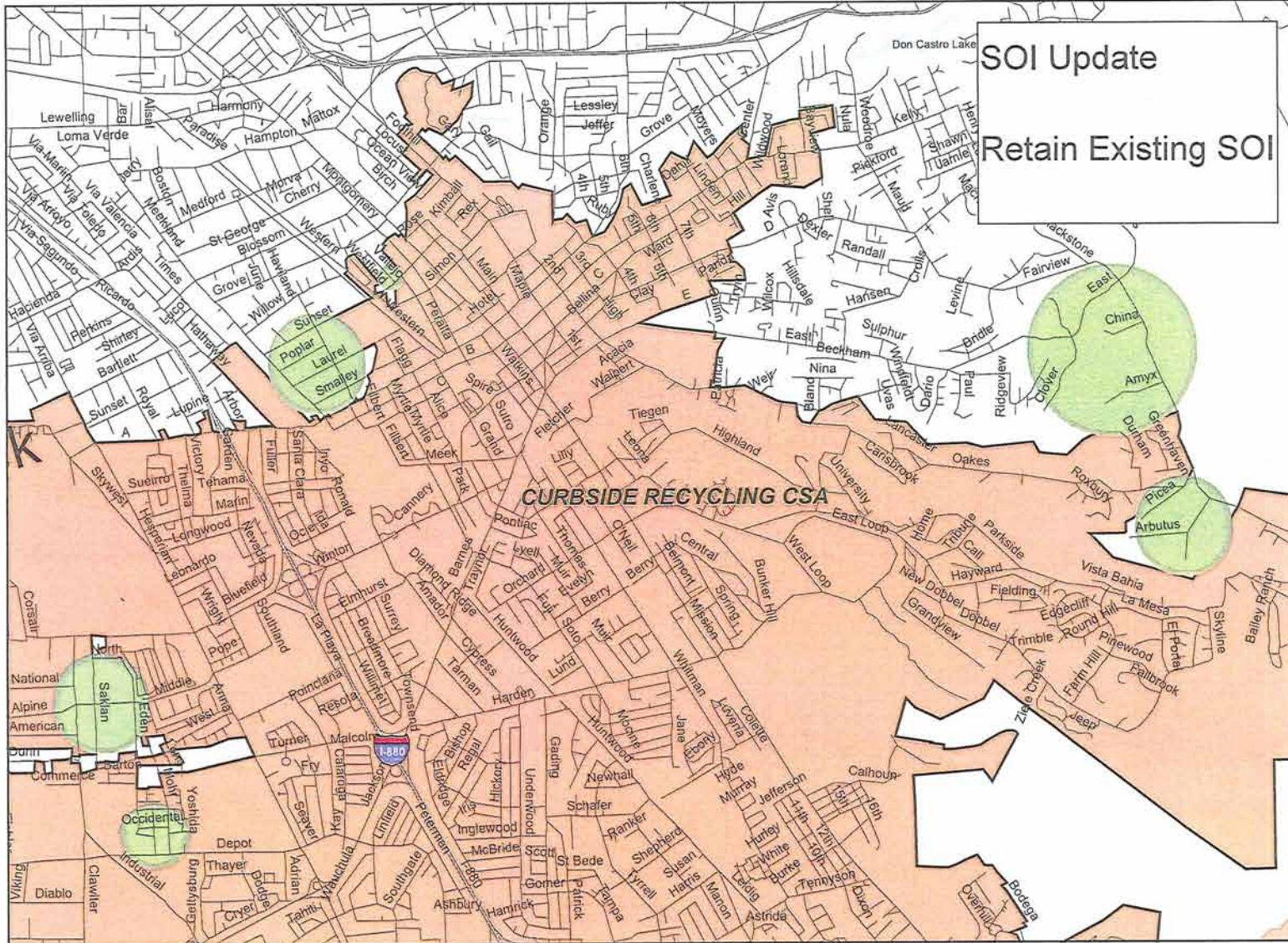

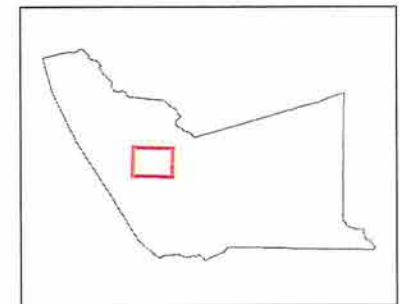


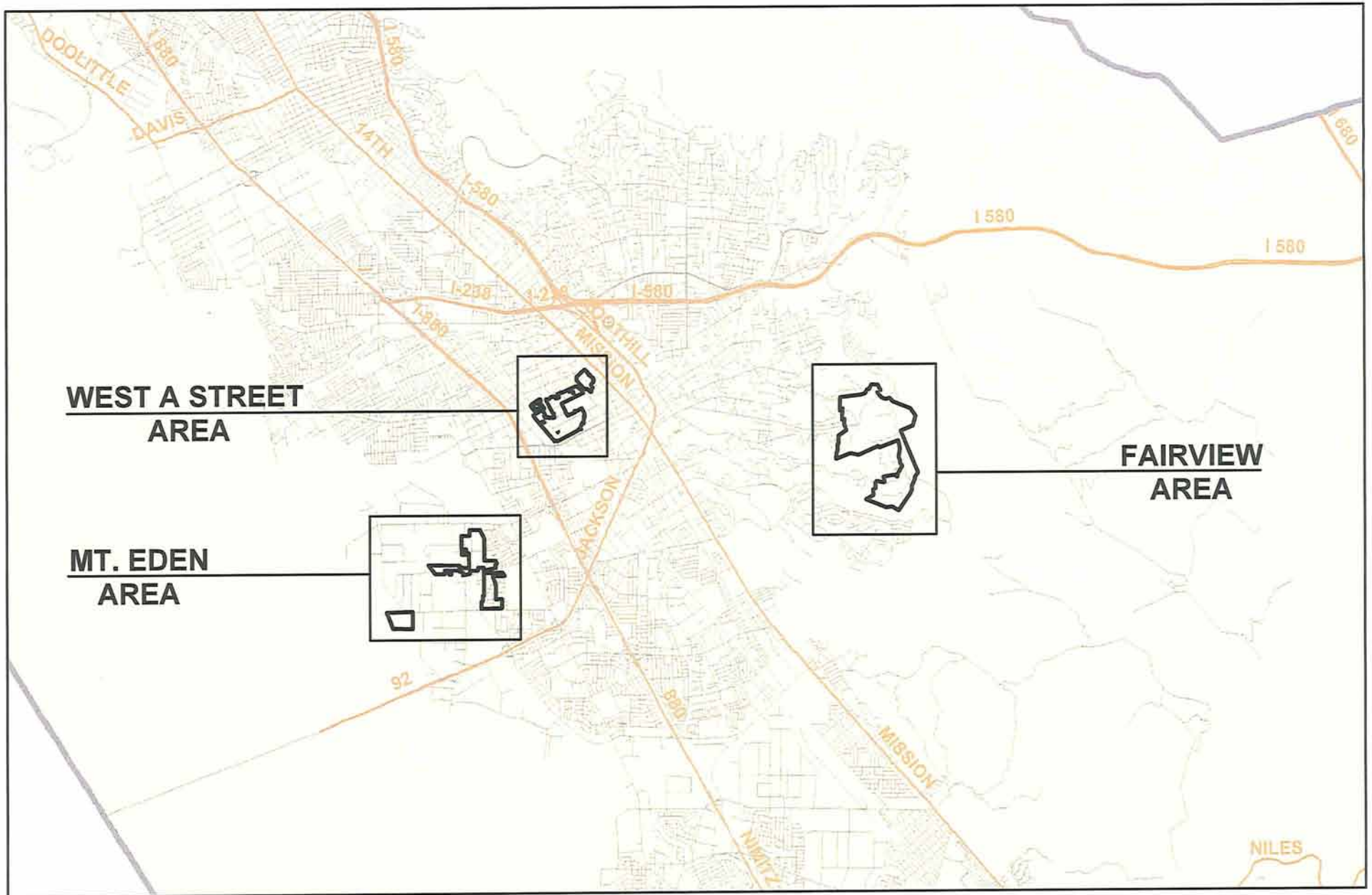

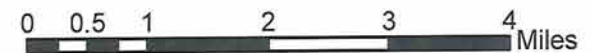
Alameda County Reference Map



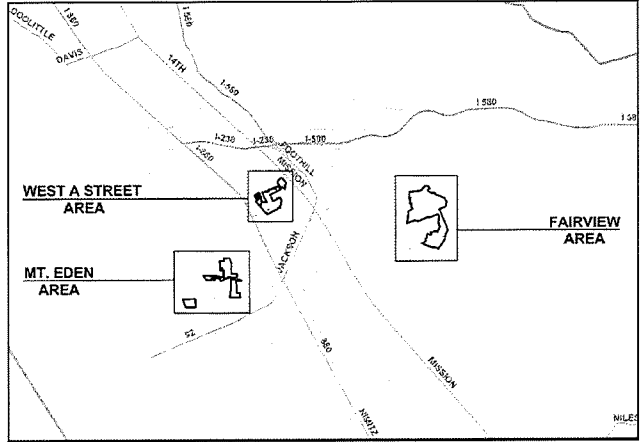
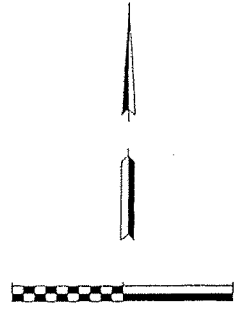
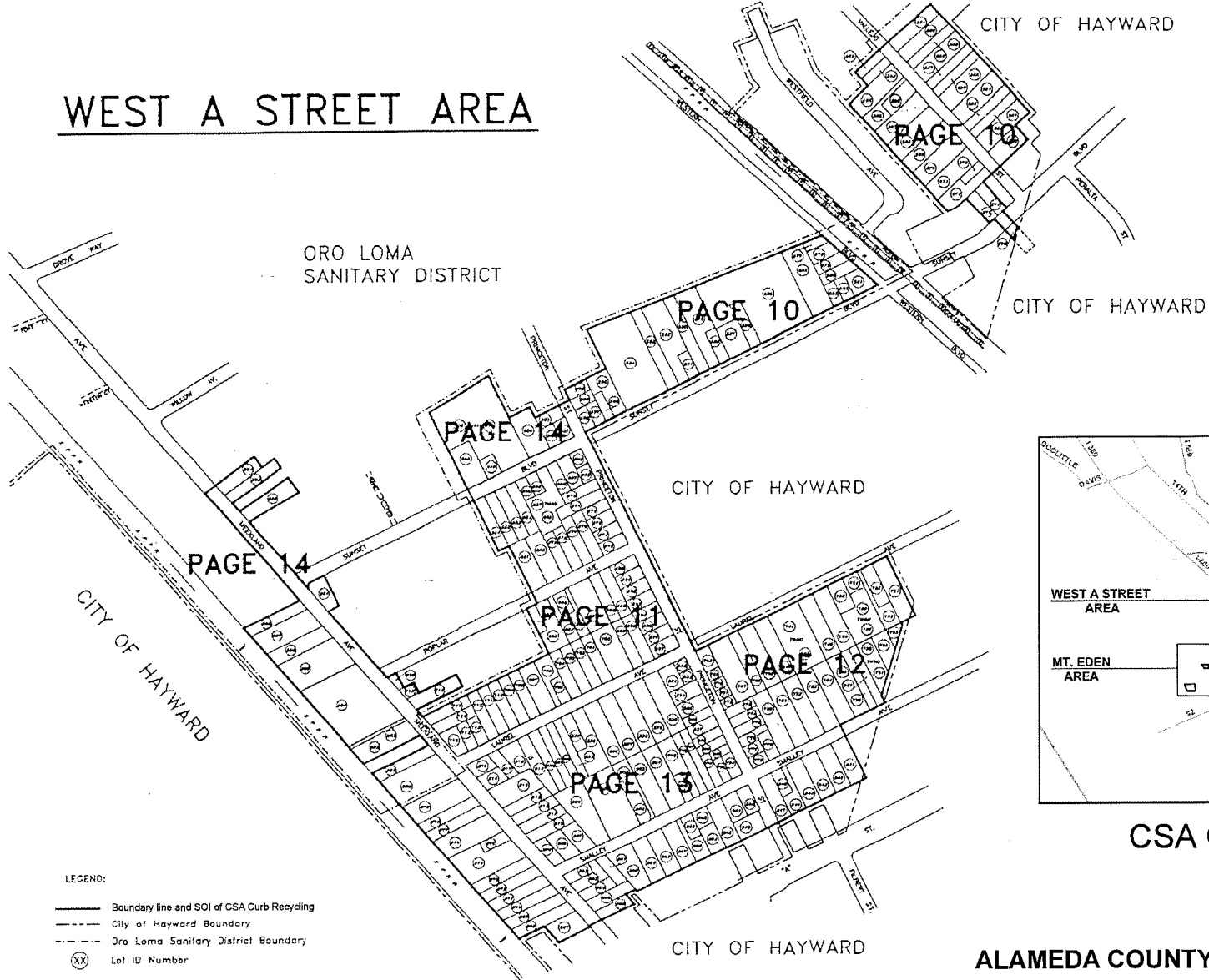

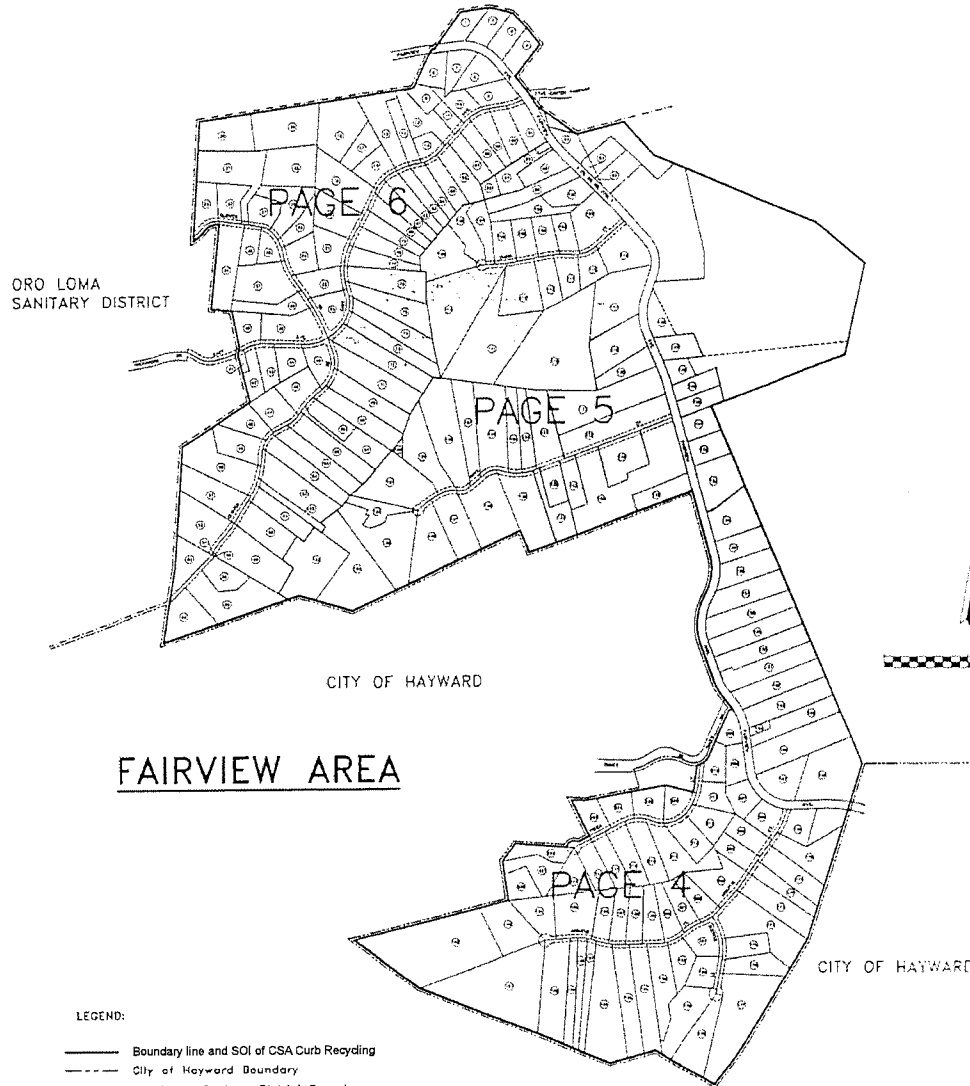


CSA OVERVIEW MAP ↑

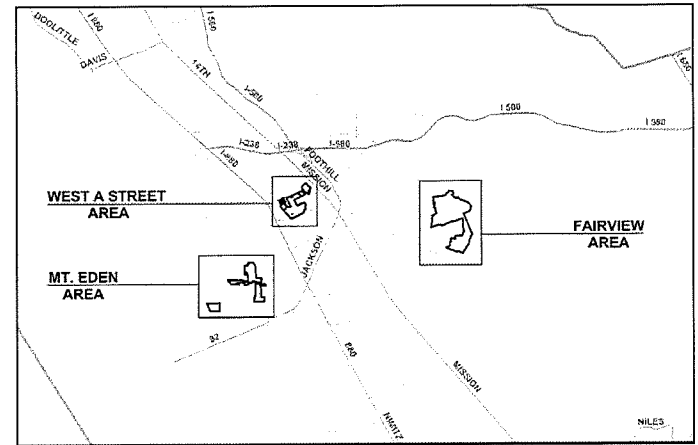
